Create a $\underline{2}$ sided postcard (4 x 6) written from the perspective of one of the characters in your book.

Side 1: Picture or illustration on the front of the setting, an important scene or episode from the book.

Side 2: Written message

Include the following questions:

- · Where are you?
- How did you get to your destination?
- Why are you there?
- Is it a pleasant place to visit? Why or why not?
- · What have you learned from your journey?
